Now there's a way to have a great family camping experience without any of the hassle and Mom doesn't have to cook.

Just load your family into the car and bring only your sleeping bag, flashlight and toothbrush. No food to buy, tents to set up, and no cooking. Gorgeous mountain setting adjacent to Bass Lake approximately four hours from San Francisco and Los Angeles in the Sierra Yosemite National Forest just 20 miles from south gate into Yosemite.

Each family has exclusive use of one of the 34 rustic bunkhouses that sleep up to eight family members. The 6500 square foot lodge is where meals and gatherings occur. Four large shower houses provide ample space for the approximately 125. Relax and enjoy the large deck with the lake peeking through the trees.

Delicious and healthy mountain style buffet and BBQ meals are all included. Full range of camp activities available for family fun along with counselor guided activities in crafts, water skiing, horseback riding, and nightly campfires. Everyone receives a free horseback ride.

Skylake weekend begins with a Thursday night arrival, with full meal service Friday and Saturday, along with Breakfast and Lunch on Sunday.

Skylake Yosemite Camp serves as a traditional Children's summer camp from the middle of June through the middle of August. Family camp occurs at the facility both prior to and after our children's camp season. Skylake offers three weekends in the spring and five weekends in the fall for families.



- A typical day includes:
- Breakfast at 8:00 a.m.
 - Crafts and open activities all morning
 - Waterfront open 9:30 to 4:30 every day (full and free use of canoes and kayaks)
 - Lunch
 - Open activities with continued horseback riding
 - Dinner at 6:00 p.m.
 - Campfire
 - Lodge activities
