Enrollment 2023

It was another fast paced enrollment season. By the close of priority enrollment for returning campers, we had a return rate of 85% from last summer. It is incredibly rewarding to see familiar names streaming in and knowing they are counting the days until the next summer. We had many new siblings applying, and for the youngest age groups (where we knew we would have the space) we were able to fit them in right away. In the older age groups, we must wait to fit in new siblings until right after priority enrollment closes to guarantee a returning camper has a spot (if they applied during priority enrollment). Thankfully we were able to accommodate just about all of the new siblings who applied in these early months.

Processing of new camper applications began on Nov. 1st with over 200 applications pending, which was a new record. Many of these are from new families who have heard stories about Skylake from their friends. There is truly no better compliment than to know our campers are talking about their magical experiences from the previous summer with others. We could see that many of the new applicants had submitted an inquiry on our website, and we do our best to fit in these families who submitted early interest. We wish we could have accommodated everyone who signed up so early, yet many campers were waitlisted in our age groups that have the highest demand. We have more wiggle room in the younger age groups and on the boys' side of camp. We work diligently throughout the year to manage our waitlists and fill cancellations as they come in.

While there is no way of accurately predicting how many cancellations we will receive, we tend to see clusters of cancellations around the new year, and again before March 15th, and then fewer just before summer, but they do occur. We ask families who are currently on the wait list to be patient. We welcome you to check in for updates, and if your plans have changed and you no longer need to be on our waitlists, it would be helpful to let us know. This will give us more realistic expectations to those families still on the waitlist.



Skylake & Covid - Planning for 2023

The world seems to be operating in a “new normal” with respect to Covid. Schools and youth sports have an occasional reminder to test your child before returning from a holiday break or stay home if you’re not feeling well, etc. and this has been working well for the most part. Most of us are doing what feels right for us and our families. Some are still masking up in public, while others have returned to life pre-covid. As we have become acutely aware by this phase of Covid, everyone has different risk levels and must make choices that work for them.

Skylake has operated two summers in the post Covid world, with many program modifications and safety protocols to keep campers and staff safe, while still making Skylake feel like Skylake. Provided no new variants arrive before next summer, camp will run much like 2022 with more things returning to “our normal.” We will still run a smart and safe camp, because no one wants their time at camp interrupted by Covid.

What will things look like? Our return to the more traditional bus structure in 2022 was effective. We still masked up on the ride. This worked well and may look very similar this year. **We will be asking for a Covid test before coming to camp and we will run tests again upon arrival.**

Opening and closing days are normally filled with energy and are very exciting. We had the expectation and desire to return to our traditional closing day ceremonies and brunches in 2022 and unfortunately felt the risk of having large crowds in our fully tested and Covid free camp bubble was too high. Our goal for 2023 is to hold these ceremonies at the end of each four-week session at the very least, if not after all four sessions. Our decision will be announced later in the year *and subject to conditions at the time.*

Care Packages were allowed again in 2022, and brought a lot of joy and normalcy back. *More on care packages to come in our Parents Handbook.* They are still permitted and encouraged, however with LESS CANDY please and following the size restrictions detailed in the parent handbook.

Dining Outdoors the past two years has had its positives and negatives, mostly positive for the campers, but presented more challenges for our kitchen staff. The occasional rain shower or windy day made it interesting, but the outdoor dining space below the lakeside porch gave campers a spectacular “lake view” while dining. We want to transition back to family style meals, which was hard with everyone spread out but we are committed to finding a way. We know the constant buffet lines started to get old, as we normally only do breakfast as a buffet. **Hoppers and family style meal service will return whether we are inside or out.**

Seniors and CILTS were able to return to the joy of trips to Miller’s (with masking) towards the end of the summer. We expect to continue the Miller’s tradition for these oldest campers.

Off-site visits during our changeover weekends were eliminated in 2021 and became a permanent policy as of Summer 2022. Families with campers staying for four weeks will be permitted for a camp visit on our closing days, but are no longer permitted to take their campers out of camp.

Covid Vaccinations were required of all campers and staff in 2022 which we found to be a very effective prevention protocol for the conditions at that time. Skylake had very few cases of Covid in camp and any cases were quickly contained to prevent spreading. A fully vaccinated camp population helped prevent widespread transmission. **For 2023, Skylake will again be requiring all Staff to be “up to date” on their Covid vaccine.** Skylake supports the CDC’s recommendation for remaining up to date, and we have updated our policy for campers from a requirement last year, to a strong recommendation for 2023. We will still be collecting vaccination cards to have on record along with all other immunization records. As our regular pediatric immunization policy states, if a camper is not vaccinated for a preventable disease or illness as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics, Skylake reserves the right to send a child home in the event of an outbreak in camp.

The updated parents handbook will be sent to all families in the Spring. All of these policies and procedures will be clearly outlined. Please do not hesitate to call us with any question or concerns.

The CAMPANION Mobile App

Skylake has upgraded CampMinder functionality with the addition of the **Campanion app**, which has now been in use over the past two seasons. We can see that it has added great value for parents looking to get a glimpse into their child's experience at camp. While we have always posted daily photos and news on the Camp in Touch website (*visible from your computer*) the addition of the Campanion app on your mobile device has improved the experience for busy parents. We heard from many happy parents how much they enjoyed seeing the daily photos from camp while on the go, often while in-between meetings. And with the face finder technology, the need to scroll through a 100 photos to find your child is no longer necessary. Campanion performs automated photo tagging just for you, and will send you push notifications when a photo of your child is uploaded. Our philosophy of taking photos and sharing just enough, but not all of the camper's experience, as to give the child their independence and a healthy amount of separation for parents too, really has not changed much with this new feature. You won't see several photos of your camper each day, but when they do show up in photos, they are now that much easier to view and then download to your phone for free.

In order to see the most value in the app, we ask that families download the app and sign in well before camp. Additionally, the Camper Forms that we will release in the spring can all be submitted easier than ever before through the app! We will announce all required Health and Travel forms in an email in the spring to be completed through the app or on the computer if you prefer through your existing Camp in Touch online account.

Each parent on the camper account has access to download this app and then log in with their own Camp in Touch log in. This is the very same email and password you used to sign up for camp. And for the parent who didn't submit the application and haven't logged into Camp in Touch before, we can send you a link to set up your own password. See the bullet point on #2 below.

To get started with Campanion, follow these three simple steps:

1. Download the Campanion app to your phone today from the App store on your iPhone, or Play Store from your Android.
2. **Find the app on your phone and login** to the app using your Camper Account login email and password (the same one you use for Camp in Touch). **Parents should each download the app and use their own email to log in. We do not recommend sharing the same login.** *If one parent ever changes a password after forgetting it for example, it would then lock the other parent out from logging in, so we really advise each parent log in as themselves.* The app is free for each parent in both the primary and alternate household.
 - **For parents who have not used Camp In Touch** (*i.e. you are not the parent filling out the forms and application each year*) and don't know what your password is, we can email you a password reset link to set up a password with the log in email we have on account for you. If you receive emails from us, we have a login email for you, you just need to set up a password. Give us a call or email us at registration@skylake.com.
3. Once the app is downloaded on your phone, you will be prompted to Upload a reference photo of your child - **IMPORTANT - You must take this reference photo before they leave for camp to have the tagged photos feature work.** Once one parent takes the camper reference photo, it is set up on all parent devices. Only one parent needs to do this step. A new training photo is required annually for returning campers, and CampMinder clears the old photos out each spring.

This information will all be provided again to you in the 2023 Parent Handbook mailed to all enrolled families in the spring. If you have any questions at all, please give us a call and we would be happy to help!

Where our 2023 Campers are Coming From

Geographic enrollment patterns have been fairly static over the years. We have predominantly been a California Camp with 90% of campers from the Golden state, and 10% from other states and international combined. The California campers are split, about 45% from Southern California and 55% from Northern California. This year's out of state campers are up from 10% last year to 12% this year, of which 2% are international campers coming from France, Spain, Hong Kong, Mexico and Australia. The 10% from other U.S. states now represents more states than ever before. We have 72 campers coming from the following states combined: Arizona, Colorado, Connecticut, Georgia, Hawaii, Idaho, Illinois, Massachusetts, Montana, New Jersey, Nevada, New York, Oregon, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin and Wyoming.

Our California campers come from over 250 different schools. There are approximately 10 schools that send between 7 to 14 campers to Skylake annually. Larchmont Charter School now seems to lead the charge with the highest number of campers from Southern California at 17, although Larchmont has four campuses. Another school with more than one campus and sending 20 campers total from the Northern California is the French American school. Other schools with high numbers include Town School for Boys, Marin Country Day School, John Thomas Dye, Harvard Westlake, Live Oak School, and Paul Revere Middle School.

Staff Training 2023

Staff Training preparations begin in January. Once it starts, it is seven full days with 25 full team workshops and 4 small group workshops where we dig into meaty discussions with a quarter of the team at a time. We prepare team activities, cabin and camper preparation, staff swim/lifeguard tests and of course have lots of FUN too! Ahead of our general staff training week we have a week-long "Trips Staff Training" where the Trips Team learn our program, the local area, hike all the trails, go on a backpacking trip together and learn how to lead campers on day trips, overnights, and backpacking trips. Trips staff take part in either Wilderness First Responder or Wilderness First Aid before Trips Training. In addition, prior to our standard week of training, is what we call our "Specialty Training" that focuses on Ropes Course training for a select group of staff as well as Lifeguard training. We also hold a separate training for our Leadership Team during this time. Staff training is something we work on year-round and take great pride in, as we know it sets the tone for the entire summer.

The week of our General Staff training for all staff includes workshops ranging from "Parent's Expectations" to "Stress and Conflict Management" to "Fostering Friendships" to "Safety" and "Workplace Harassment." While we focus on many fun and practical topics during staff training, we also have several required Human Resource workshops to prepare our team for camp while following all of the California employee laws, OSHA requirements and more. It's a jam-packed week and one that we always enjoy, as we bring together so many personalities, new and old friends, staff from inside California and all the way to the UK, together to create a team who are ready to take on what we describe as, "The most important job they will ever have!" Staff Training continues as the summer goes on through weekly meetings, teambuilding activities, staff evaluations and mid-summer workshops.

A lot of what happens at camp, and what we call "Skylake Magic," happens organically. Children and staff bring much of this magic. But when we start with a strong focus on our mission and our "why" spending this time connecting with each other and learning how to support each other we create a team that is ready for "the most important job ever!"



Camp Maintenance & an Evolving Tradition

We are busy all winter maintaining and improving camp. Many of our projects go under the radar such as upgrading electrical panels and outdated light fixtures to energy efficient LED's, while others are very visible. The wooden fenced dumpster corrals built a few years ago near the office were a great improvement to hide dumpsters and has deterred the bears successfully. We have now added two additional fenced corrals surrounding the parking lot dumpsters entering camp.

Continual work of stripping and staining the exterior of the cabins continues. This is a project that always improves the outward appearance. The interior of the cabins has become a larger focus as we look for ways to update and brighten the space. Having two newly built cabins with beautiful bright pine interiors made the contrast much more obvious. Since the first years of Skylake, campers and staff have added their names to the interior of cabins. It is one of the many small traditions that Alumni talk about and look forward to finding their now faded name written in Sharpie along with the year they lived in that cabin. However, over the years, this "tradition" has been abused by some. The names started to get large and overbearing, colorful language was being included, and drawings started to appear with too much regularity. Our staff now must inspect walls of each cabin at the beginning and close of each session to make sure nothing inappropriate was added. We then have had to paint over and make phone calls to parents. We decided it was time to try something different.

We found bringing the wood back to the original clean state with a power sander was the look that we wanted to achieve instead of paint. It has been a labor of love for our maintenance staff. After sanding, we will be raising some of the bunks as we re-attach them, to give some additional head room for those on the bottom bunks. We know this will be a great improvement and is now a scheduled project to get all bunks completed in the next few years.

The removal of the names because of the graffiti they turned into, will bring mixed emotions. We know traditions are a part of Skylake, and this one was important. As with the changing times, some traditions must also evolve. We have plans to evolve this tradition by providing a plaque as part of a cabin group activity with each of the campers in the cabin signing the plaque (along with their counselor) and these will be mounted inside the cabin. We know it may not be immediately embraced, however the fresh brighter appearance in the cabins will be a welcome sight.
